- Please email your request 48 hours in advance of your ride date.
- We try to respond within a 24 hour period, but sometimes school demands increase response time.

Riders are prohibited from...

Littering	Smoking, fires, campfires, open flames	Drinking alcoholic beverages
Disturbing livestock	Removing firewood	Bringing unregistered guests to ride
Trail bike riding	Driving vehicles on trails. Permission is for trailer parking only	ENTERING SCHOOL PROPERTY WITHOUT PRIOR PERMISSION BEFORE EACH VISIT

I understand that :

- *Midland School gives permission for riding as a courtesy and does not accept responsibility for accidents or injuries of any kind.*
- *Riders should be prepared to encounter potentially hazardous conditions including livestock and wildlife on the trails (including coyotes, bears, mountain lions, wild pigs and rattlesnakes.*
- ***Permission does NOT extend to your friends.*** *All riders must call for permission to ride and sign the necessary paperwork prior to riding.*
- ***Do not unhitch your vehicle to drive beyond the trailer parking area.*** *The permit is to PARK a horse trailer only.*
- ***Firewood is a resource only available to Midland staff and students.***
- *Any of 3 infractions will permanently terminate your permission to ride on Midland trails.*

- 1. Failing to email in advance for permission.***
- 2. Sharing the gate code.***
- 3. Bringing a non-registered guest rider***

- ***I am NOT ALLOWED to give the gate lock combination out to a friend.***
